1C. PUBLISHABLE PROJECT RESULTS SUMMARY

The goal of TOPIC was to understand informal caregivers' needs and design ICT solutions to support them in their daily needs. TOPIC provides a solution "TOPIC *CarePortfolio*" to the lack of an integrated social support and network platform, which serves all relevant aspects of caregivers' social support needs in form of adequate integration of products and services required; and the lack of accessible ICT applications for elderly that might automate many tasks of general care giving. We designed, developed, evaluated, and deployed the TOPIC *CarePortfolio* in more than 50 households of elderly informal caregivers (in total there were more than 60 users in total, in all phases of the project). It is an integrated set of shared spaces and services, to support the physical and mental care ability of informal carers, to support their mobility while caring, to provide social support in three dimensions: informational, tangible, and emotional: by enabling learning and orientation about care, by offering a platform for cooperation with formal carers, by improving, integrating, and making (mobile) multimodal communication easier and accessible for informal carers to connect with other informal carers, friends, and family members. The idea is to create a holistic system for the informal caregivers enabling consistent user experience throughout all modules it contains for all supported end user devices, PCs, tablets, smartphones. The implemented Single-sign-on enables easy and only one access to all modules of it. Its usable and intuitive interfaces and interaction mechanisms provide an easy access for elderly informal caregivers using several devices. It is scalable and responsive.

Our users need a safe social network dedicated to informal care where they can find people experiencing similar situations and where they can have easy contact to professional carers. Experience sharing and collaborative problem solving is often necessary in their several care and life situations for which TOPIC provides a forum like space to interact with and help each other through the provision of tips and advices. Sometimes they also need professional help individually via a direct secure communication channel. Care work must be coordinated, but informal carers options are very limited. They need support in planning appointments, in sharing and communicating their care responsibilities with other (in)formal caregivers, in finding a way to check on their care receivers' status when they need to be absent. They need easy mechanisms for video interaction accessed through a simple and usable interface for one-to-one as well as group video chats. Furthermore, they need official and validated information about different types of services, resources and support (e.g., financial) as well as about basic care procedures.

TOPICs customers as target groups are consumers, health insurances, professional care, large companies, and household companies. The *TOPIC Business Model* developed in the project aims large companies and their employees who care for their family members. They are both physically and mentally higher stressed out, which in any case involves a high risk to their employer. A reduced job performance, a lower resistance to stress, frequent absences, and subsequently reduced regenerative capacity cause employees and Human Resources managers problems. With each new day of informal care giving the situation becomes more disappointing for all stakeholders. The *TOPIC Business Model* supports caregivers in taking care of the care receiver at home in an emergency while they are working. SOPHIA will implement this model; the expected time to market is one year.

Innovation was one of the driving goals and was defined in this project on three levels:

- Social level – from user's perspective by lowering the burden and stress by an integrated and holistic platform addressing emotional and informal care needs; from market's perspective by offering new services by organisations and associations.
- User interaction level – by integrating different input and output devices: PCs, mobile devices like tablets and smart phones, smart watches; by providing scientific proven care knowledge and interaction with professionals.
- Technological level – because it is easy to deploy and work with; there is no extra software to install; and it is affordable because of its low cost.

2. DELIVERABLES SUBMITTED AND MILESTONES ACHIEVED DURING THE PROJECT

Milestones

- M.1: 01/05/2013 >> 07/06/2013 Kick off meeting with all project partners
One German partner opted out and this caused a delay of one month at the project start. This has throughout a negative impact on the project schedule.
- M.2: 01/11/2013 >> 01/12/2013 Start of technical development
Due to the delay at the beginning of the project, there is a delay of one month with M.2.
- M.3: 01/05/2014 >> 01/06/2014 Start of prototyping
The delay at the beginning of the project, there is a delay of one month with M.3. This is a follow-up delay.
- M.4: 01/05/2015 >> 01/06/2015 Start of field evaluation
Due to the delay at the beginning of the project, there is a delay of one month with M.4. This is a follow-up delay.

Duration of the project: Because of the delay in Germany (one partner opted out and the German partners did start 3 months later on 01.08.2013), all partners in Austria and France did start on 01.06.2013 (one month later). The consortium has decided for an extension of three months. The funding bodies (AAL EU and national agencies) approved this suggestion (February 2016).

Consortium composition: LOKEO is no longer part of the project. A new version of the Description of Work (DoW) had to be established (version/work: 28.03.2014) after the drop out of LOKEO. The main difference is, that the remaining French business partner WEBINAGE takes over the business plan from LOKEO's responsibilities, while the university partner UTT will buy the devices for the French users. The French National Agency ANR has already approved the changes and the new contracts have been signed. Funding budgeted for LOKEO will be available to WEBINAGE (for business plan) and UTT (for devices). The updated DoW was sent to the FFG.

Project staff members: There was some changes in staff for TUW. TUW reduced the staff effort in the whole project (to balance the calculation error happened in the plan of the finances of TUW) starting in May 2014, so a new plan with the goal of achieving the project aims without increasing the costs have been established. That means, there were changes in the project staff. WEBINAGE, AVINOTEC and SOGL had also changed in staff.

3 A. PROJECT RESULTS - SCIENTIFIC/TECHNICAL PROJECT RESULTS

Our objectives, methods, technology suggestions are the same as described in the DoW. The project has started one month later in Austria and France and three months later in Germany. Extending the project for additional three months could catch this. The aimed goals could be achieved; the quality and quantity of the outcome are as planned; the staff effort of some partners was modified; the planned project cost is not increased. All partners were active, productive, and cooperative in all WPs. WP1: Finding the users for the project, studying them to understand their life situation and their needs,

deriving use cases based on the gathered and analysed data to deliver for WP2 and WP3 were the main achievements of the WP1. Furthermore based on all knowledge and experiences gained in TOPIC an ethics manual has been created. All deliverables but D1.2 were on time.

WP2: Defining the IT specification and architecture of the TOPIC *CarePortfolio*, designing, implementing, testing, and updating the mock-ups prototypes and the final portfolio as a holistic platform, in cooperation with WP1, WP3 and WP4 were main achievements of the WP2. We made changes to the requirements we originally inquired in WP1 based on the review results of the Mid Term Review in December 2014. The process was user-centred and iterative by involving the users just from the beginning. All deliverables of WP2 were on time.

WP3: Contents and services are defined, created, and updated in several formats with different foci: video material with text and audio support to most relevant and common care procedures; "Microstandards" containing several care-related instructions for our informal caregivers in a well-structured easy-to-understand way; a well-selected list of links to interesting useful sources on care and caring in respective countries; ENP® as a source of care information directly from the professionals. Additionally, social-technical accompany measures, tools, and services were developed as well as the way to communicate care-related information with our target group has been identified and implemented.

WP4: Users were involved for evaluation and testing of the TOPIC *CarePortfolio* in all stages of the development. First, several usability tests have been conducted across the three countries. Then during the longitudinal studies (LS) our users evaluated the TOPIC *CarePortfolio* for almost one year: 22 households in Austria, 22 in Germany, and 9 in France. LS delivered use documentation, analysis of the users' feedback, new requirements or change requests to WP2 and WP3, update of the TOPIC *CarePortfolio* within a very short time span.

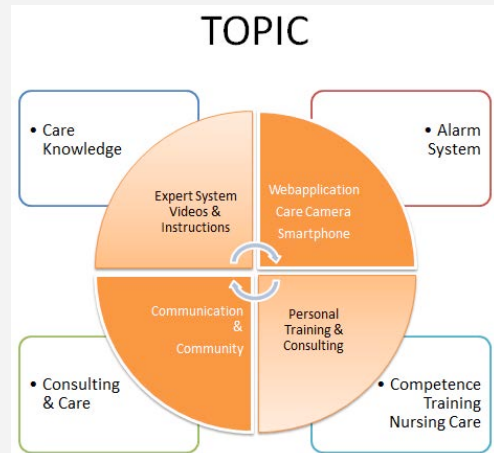
WP5: Based on the dissemination plan created all partners carried out and documented their activities on several venues. There are a huge number of dissemination activities carried out throughout the project, with several highlights among others like CCCiC Workshop Series and the final event at the end of the project. Developing the "TOPIC Business Model" was one of the main tasks in this WP, which has been successfully finished.

WP6: After creating a detailed project plan and the quality handbook, the project was managed successfully on a daily base. Due to the late start in Germany WP6 had a slight delay in delivery of D6.1 and D6.2. The delivery date of the D6.3 is rescheduled to match the annual AAL progress report. All further deliverables were delivered as planned. The performance of all partners was as planned and we did not have any problems in the distribution of work, decision processes, agreement in intellectual property rights, and quality assurance. We had a well integrated, good functioning, and cooperative consortium. We organised and coordinated the delivery dates of single efforts in order to avoid inefficiency; the regular electronic and face-to-face consortium meetings were very useful in this matter. Additionally, we used several tools like JIRA, BSCW to manage the work successfully and keep it transparent to all within the consortium throughout the project.

End-user services: User focus groups were held in Austria, France, and Germany. A benefit was that they provided a space in which users could meet each other and discuss several issues and create a common understanding about the TOPIC *CarePortfolio* with several functions and contents. Other services were online or f2f technical support during the LS, Professional Service directly by professional carers, keeping the system one year longer online for the users, and devices users had for an attractive price.

3 B. PROJECT RESULTS – BUSINESS MODELS & INDICATORS

The TOPIC Business Model addresses to companies, which want to offer their employees an answer to the problems of time, shame, and unexpected situation in relation to their domestic care responsibilities. It can be integrated as a life phase-oriented personnel management instrument, which adapts flexibly to the changing conditions of a modern working life. It helps quickly, easily and is tailored to the needs of each individual employee. It offers elderly care knowledge, an emergency aid, and also preventive assistance, so that the worst case does not occur:



- Care Knowledge, for preventive support to avoid long term care or to lessen the consequences, using expert system videos and instructions
- Consulting & Care, communication & community module to stay in touch with the care receiver during the day
- Alarm System, possibly with online voice or camera connection to the care receiver
- Competence Training and Nursing Care, online care information and "geriatric assessments" for the execution of tests by which the health of the elderly relative is checked, if necessary, to take preventive measures

In Europe, 186 Mio of inhabitants are aged 50+ (36.9% of total). 25.6% of them provide some sort of care. This means that there are 47.6 Mio caregivers in Europe. 6.5% deliver intensive personal care (20h+/week). This makes 12.3 Mio people. Calculation of the revenue for SOPHIA:

The resources those are necessary to create value for the customer. They are considered an asset to a company, which are needed in order to sustain and support the business. These resources could be human, financial, physical, and intellectual. - Content: Expert system videos and instructions, training materials, geriatric assessments, - People: For content management, for user relation management, for TOPIC <i>CarePortfolio</i> management. <u>Value Propositions:</u> The TOPIC <i>CarePortfolio</i> offers a variety of products and services in different service packages: - The basic service, i.e., account to the TOPIC <i>CarePortfolio</i> and access to the ICT modules, first consultancy and support on the care situation helping them to reconcile care and work, and improving their social life and health conditions; - The TOPIC expert system, i.e., a knowledge system for informal carers based on ENP® (European Nursing care Pathways) adapted for the care interventions at home to improve the knowledge of care, skills, and competences; - An upgrade service, i.e., assistance with TOPIC services like care camera and smartphone app. This involves that the client signs an informed consent about the service with the care organisation when signing the service contract; and - A package, which includes access to the community portal for another family members. An alternative model (B2B) could be: - Base (Self-service): access to online resources – monthly fee per number of employees - Premium: additional access to personal training and consulting – additional monthly fee This business plan is a <u>cost-driven model</u>; this business model focuses on minimising all costs and having no frills. This tactic is meant for the start and market entrance. <u>Characteristics of Cost Structures</u> - Fixed Costs: Costs are unchanged across different applications, see table above. - Variable Costs: These costs vary depending on the amount of services. These costs will occur in case of including special services like sensors, smartphone apps, etc. - Economies of Scale: Costs go down as the amount of services (number of registered users) is delivered. <u>Revenue Streams – Subscription Fees</u> The revenues are generated by selling a continuous service, in this model there will be a contract with a minimum of duration for each user paid per month (possible to be paid in advance), the monthly fee depends on being employed or not.	

A possible model for the future can be a licensing model for the whole platform tailored for a specific company; i.e., one bigger company with its own IT-infrastructure could host its own TOPIC *CarePortfolio*. The revenue would be generated from charging for the use of a protected intellectual property. A monthly fee for maintenance and support would provide further development and improvement and professional support of SOPHIA.

In addition advertising can generate revenues; this means for care giving related ads there could be charged fees for product advertising.

3 C. PROJECT RESULTS – END USER INDICATORS

In line with the project objectives, we have defined three groups of end-users, according to the three main phases where strong interactions with end-users are needed:

1. Contribute to the project promotion and to the dissemination of its results;
2. Pre study;
3. Usability tests;
4. Longitudinal study.

The distribution of the 30 participants in each country will then be the following:

- 10 participants for the pre-study (T1.2). These participants will participate during the 3 years of the project, from the pre-study to the longitudinal field study (T4.3).
- 10 other participants who will be involved only in the usability tests' sessions (T4.1, T4.2).
- 10 other participants to join the 10 initial participants for the longitudinal field tests (the system will be installed in their homes) (T4.3).

Due to the uncertainties and the potential changes that may occur in the participants' life during the three years of the TOPIC project, the WP1 stakeholders have chosen to develop contact with more participants than the initial 30 and to pursue the recruitment concurrently with the different project phases. In particular, the pre study group has been identified as the most important one, so the recruitment is actually focused on this group, and the WP1 partners plan to recruit more than 10 people in each country.

The WP1 partners have collectively defined the inclusion criteria for the informal carers participating to the project. These criteria are:

- 50+ years old (extended definition of "elderly").
- Caring for other, ill or handicapped people who need full-time care (friends or family).
- Working (full or part-time) or not working/retired.
- Living or not in the same household with the care recipient.
- Based at rural or urban areas.
- Male or female.

The project members agree to try as much as possible to find a balance between persons living in urban and rural areas, and between genders among the participants.

In all participating countries the project total costs are the same as planned. There are slight deviations of the distribution of the staff effort and respectively the costs in the different phases of the project and in some cases also in the assignment to WPs. As documented so far, there is a reduction of PM at TUW due to the calculation problems at the beginning of the project. There are no indications that the reduction of PMs caused any quality or quantity problems in the project work carried out by TUW or in the outcomes of the project. Neither the opting out of LOKEO did cause any damage to the project progress and outcomes. All costs and staff effort are documented and explained in detail in the management reports I-III and final report of the WP6.

5. AAL JP PROGRAMME

The main advantage of AAL JP projects is to build a consortium not only across disciplines (like universities, companies, user organisations) but also to cross countries to get to know differences and similarities among EU cultures. This would not be achieved otherwise. At the same time, this is the biggest challenge of this programme. There is a big need for mediating between different work cultures, methodologies, and values. In projects like TOPIC this complexity increases because of the user involvement in all phases of the project.

A disadvantage is the short time that is given to run the research, study, development, field evaluation, rollout, and deployment within and outside the project. This is not easy to manage. Another year would be necessary to really disseminate the product at market.
